British Virgin Islands Electricity Corporation
(Amendment) By-Laws, 2026

[Gazetted 23rd June, 2026]

The British Virgin Islands Electricity Corporation, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 33 of the British Virgin Islands Electricity Corporation Ordinance, Cap. 277, and with the approval of the Minister, makes these By-Laws.

Citation and commencement

1. (1) These By-Laws may be cited as the British Virgin Islands Electricity Corporation (Amendment) By-Laws, 2026.

(2) These By-Laws shall come into force on the date that the Statutory Rates, Fees and Charges (Amendment of Schedule) (No. 2) Order, 2026 comes into force.

Third Schedule amended

2. The British Virgin Islands Electricity Corporation By-Laws is amended in the Third Schedule by repealing paragraph 1(2) and substituting the following new subparagraphs:

“(2) In addition to the rates in subparagraph (1), a fuel oil surcharge per unit of electricity (Kwh) consumed will be added or deducted. The unit rate of surcharge will be calculated in accordance with the following formula: $(a - b) \times c$, where the values of a, b and c are as follows:

a - the cost per gallon of fuel oil supplied to the Corporation in the calendar month immediately preceding the calendar month during which meters are read;

b - 81.5 cents;

c - the quantity of fuel oil in U.S. Gallons required to generate, transmit and distribute one unit of electricity (Kwh).

(2A) Notwithstanding subparagraph (2), in calculating the unit rate of surcharge applicable to the units of electricity consumed which exceed 1500 units per month per Consumer, the value of ‘b’ shall be 0 cents.”.
